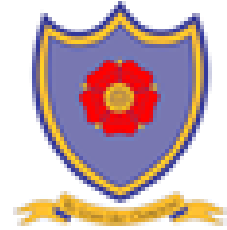


# Worsley Mesnes Primary School Newsletter

## LIVE KITCHEN

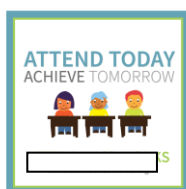
