Dear parents and carers,

Our key stage 2 children have been invited to join in with the Chudleigh Christmas Lights Event this year. This will involve singing songs outside the church, processing with lanterns along the high street towards the war memorial and singing more songs once there.

The event will be held on Thursday 6th December 2018. Please give your consent by Monday 3rd December 2018.

Consent for this activity can be made through the School Gateway on-line system. Details and a link for the gateway are available on our school website. If you are unable to consent online, please contact the school office.

On the evening the children will need to meet at the church at 5.00PM, unless they are a member of the school orchestra, who will be meeting at 4.50PM. We anticipate that the singing at the war memorial will finish at approximately 6.15PM; please note that, due to the time of day, all children will need to be collected by an adult.

Following last year's wet weather, the organisers have decided to relocate the first part of the evening into the church, where the choir and orchestra will perform and the children will sing. This musical interlude will then be followed by a procession up to the war memorial, where the children will sing a further selection of carols (please find the words attached so that your child can practise them at home).

Children can wear casual clothes and will need a warm coat with scarves, hats and gloves. Seasonal hats/Santa hats would be most welcome.
