Important - Bad Weather Procedures:

In the event of school not being able to open, for example if staff and pupils are unable to safely get to school, we would:

1. Use the text messaging service to contact you directly
2. Post on the PTFA Facebook page
3. Inform local radio stations, such as BBC Humberside, Viking etc. who usually broadcast details of school closures
4. Inform the Transport Office as the Langtoft bus may be affected

In any event, a decision would be made as early as possible. Please make sure you do not leave your child at school until you are certain that there is



a staff member in school to receive them.

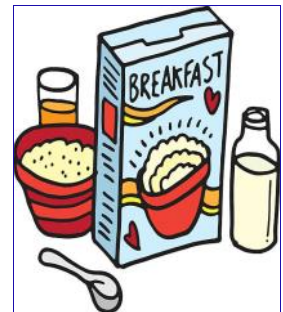
