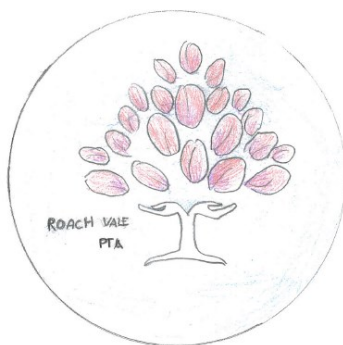
School Association Logo
