Dear Parents/Carers,

I have spent a lot of time this week talking to or teaching children across the school. In year 6 I have talked to each child about their learning. They were able to really easily articulate what they can do well and more importantly what they need to focus on to improve. We talked about reaching high and always achieving their full potential. Every child has a target that we will review together in term 3 and I hope that this will really make them feel that their voice is heard and important. I have also taught year 1 and 2 children this week – it is nice to get back in the classroom, but even nicer to see the hard work of the teachers and children.

I had a very positive meeting with the Parent Focus Group on Wednesday evening. We discussed the Parent's Evening and how the school had responded to their suggestions. The feedback was very positive and we will follow the same procedure at the meeting in March. We also spent some time discussing the 'Behaviour Management Policy' as it is due for an annual review and I felt parents should have an input. It highlighted a few areas for improvement which was very welcome – but it also highlighted what a valuable document it is to help parents understand the approach taken by the school. Once the policy has been agreed, with staff and governors, I will be sending a separate email regarding the discussion.

We have organised the next SEN Forum for Tuesday 15th January between 2-3pm at KS2. Alison Szalay, a specialist teacher from the SENS team at Wiltshire County Council, will be discussing how to support your child with literacy difficulties. Caroline Wilkinson will be available as well.

As we approach the end of term 2, I think that it is timely that we ask the view of parents following the Ofsted report and change in leadership. I would like to capture your views of the school by using this online survey <https://goo.gl/forms/gi4acnEevkpg0PDo2> . If possible, please can you respond with your views post Ofsted so that we can get a feel of how we are now performing. We will then analyse it and report back the findings by the end of term 2. We will repeat this exercise again in term 6 to ensure that views and findings are being maintained or improved. If you are unable to access the survey on-line, then we will have some computers available at the 'School Improvement' meeting on the 6th December.
