Dear Parents/Carers,

Excitement is brewing here at Bredhurst, as we begin the build up to Christmas!

Our Advent Event this afternoon kick started proceedings. The children hung their decorations and sang beautifully around the tree, which was very kindly donated by 'Farms' the Butchers in Fairview Avenue, and was decorated by Mr & Mrs Sullivan and Mr White, in the wind and rain!

The diary is always very busy at this time of year so do keep a watch for the alerts. We have tried our best to inform you of the upcoming events between now and Christmas, see below.

On **Monday** the choir are performing at Hempstead Valley at approximately 12.00p.m. Do pop over to listen to them sing! The guitars and drums are playing in worship on Monday morning, again do feel free to watch the children.

The FOBS team are in school on **Tuesday** morning to decorate the school for the children. If you have any free time your help would be appreciated.
