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Membership

Membership of the Teaching and Learning Committee shall be no fewer than 5 governors. Any member of the governing body or SLT is welcome to attend any committee meeting but only members of the committee are entitled to vote.

Quorum

3 committee members must be present for the meeting to be quorate.

Meetings

Termly, unless otherwise agreed by members of the committee, as necessary.

Terms of Reference

- To ensure the requirements of the Foundation Stage and National Curriculum are met or exceeded by the school.
- To monitor the implementation of the Early Years Foundation Stage and National Curriculum to ensure the children receive a broad and balanced curriculum relevant to their needs.
- To review periodically the broad curricular aims and objectives of the school.
- To ensure the school has curricular policies and to monitor and evaluate the implementation of these policies.
- To ensure children's learning is continually assessed and used to inform teaching and learning so that all pupils make at least expected progress from their starting points.
- To ensure high quality provision is provided for all pupils matched to their needs.
- To review all data and reports relating to the pupils and schools performance and use this to inform decisions regarding teaching, learning, staffing and resources.
- Ensure that classrooms are adequately resourced to deliver curriculum requirements.
- Increase parental awareness of teaching and learning of the whole curriculum, to encourage parental support.
- Approve proposed school trips.
- To review and monitor all policies and documents relating to this committee.
- Review Terms of Reference annually and submit amendments to the full Governing Body.
- Support the school's self-evaluation process.
- Review sections of the SIP termly.
