

They have been made aware of an emerging trend where people are playing the game using webcams and this raises safeguarding issues if children are playing on these games. We hear children talking about this game in school and want to make parents aware of this safety issue and to remind you if you are aware of any inappropriate or unlawful contact with children, this should be reported. If you do allow your child to play this game, we ask that they do not talk about it in school.
