PE and Sport Premium Funding -Academic Year 2018-19 Plan

We seek to continue to improve our provision of PE and sport by effectively using the additional funding provided to us. The impacts we are aiming for this academic year are to continue to get large percentages of children involved in both intra and inter school sport. We also wish to seek to introduce children to new sports and signpost them to extra-curricular opportunities. We wish to embed good practice through training, particularly focussing on the development of Teachers knowledge and confidence in teaching PE and to improve provision for the Early Years outside areas.

Basis of allocation

Allocations for the financial year 2017 to 2018 are calculated using the number of pupils in years 1 and 2, as recorded in the January 2017 census, as follows: Schools with 17 or more pupils receive £16,000 plus £10 per pupil.

During this academic year our school received £17,160 based on 172 children.

Our plan for the use of the 2018-19 academic year PE and Sport Premium Budget is shown below.
