Literacy

Our Phonics sessions this week have continued to focus on listening and attention skills and taking turns. The children have had a go at a Christmas dough disco exercise and have practiced how to wrap presents to go under the Christmas tree in class. The sound of the week has been the letter 'c'.

Maths

This week in Maths the children have been reviewing their work so far on size, number and shape and started to look at patterns. They have been practicing following a pattern and working out what would come next in simple alternating patterns with a Christmas theme.

We had our Christmas stay and play session last Thursday for the new children due to start in the new year and the children have been to help us transform the role play areas into The North Pole and the Elves Workshop this week.
