Next week the programme for the after school activities is as above. The week after,

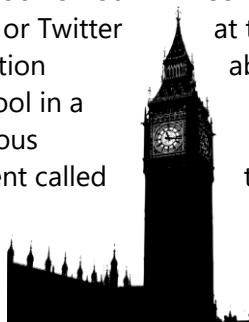
beginning Monday 17th December, there are NO activities after school.
