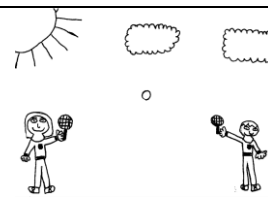
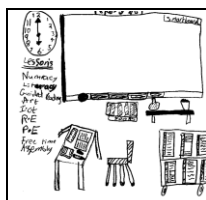

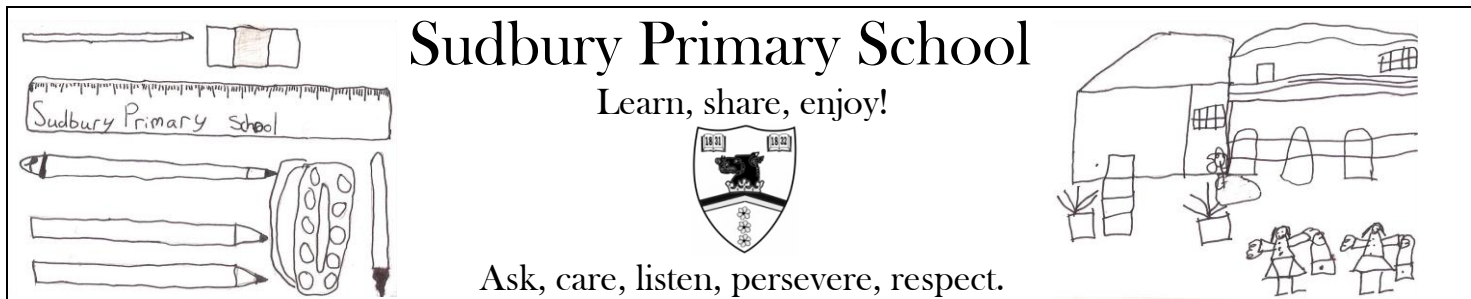
### School Pantomime Trip on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> December 2018
