




# Year 6 Menu - Spring

All work must be handwritten, so make sure you pay attention to your presentation, particularly your spelling, punctuation and grammar—this is partly what your work will be marked on. All participants will receive 25 house points with the best entry from each class receiving a £5 Tesco voucher.



## Starter



Read a book and write a short review on it (no more than one side of A4) . You need to consider: why you chose that book, who the main characters were, which genre the book was from, what happened and also if you liked it or not and why. Make sure you let us know if you would recommend this book to others and if so to whom.

## Main Course

### Meat Option

In Science we are going to be looking at the circulatory system. Show this system in a creative and interesting manner. You could build a model of a heart using papier mache or gelatine— anything that you choose. Or if you wish just draw and label one. It needs to be accurate, life size and labelled.

## Desserts

**Choice 1**— In English we are looking at Harry Potter and The Philosopher's Stone— design a new broom for Harry Potter to fly. Think about the features it would have, what this broom can do. Draw or make a model of the new broom and label it with all of the features and gadgets that it has. Think about what name you will give it.

**Choice 2**— Online Safety - Design and create an Online Safety poster which would explain to your peers what they should and should not do when online. Think about what information should and should not be shared and what to do if you have any problems. Make sure your poster is informative and eye-catching.



## Drinks

Write a short speech on the problems with stereotyping and how you or someone you know has been affected by it.
