## PE.

Our PE days this year will be on Wednesdays or Fridays. We hope to go outside as much as possible for PE this half term, therefore please ensure that your child's indoor and outdoor PE kits are in school at all times.

## Water Bottles.

## Homework.

Your child has been given a blue homework and reading diary which must be brought into school and taken home every day. On the homework page children can write their homework tasks and test scores and on the opposite page there is space for you to keep a record of the reading that your child does at home with you. We also ask that children come to school each day with their school reading book or their own choice of book if they are no longer on banded books. These should be kept, during the day, in the child's desk. Please encourage your child to read as often as possible.

It would be very helpful if you would provide your child with a plastic wallet in which to carry their homework and letters to and from school. This can also be kept in the child's desk during the day which will help them to get organised quickly at the start and end of each day. Our homework timetable is as follows:

### Homework Timetable

**Monday** - POW homework (to be brought in at the end of term).

**Tuesday** - Spellings and SPAG (Spellings will be stuck into your child's spelling book and should be learnt ready for testing the following Tuesday. SPAG homework should be completed and brought into school, ready for discussion during lessons on the following Tuesday.

**Wednesday** - Talk homework

**Thursday** - Abacus online computer homework (Via the Active Primary Website.)

**Friday** - Times Tables (to be learnt ready for testing on the following Friday).
