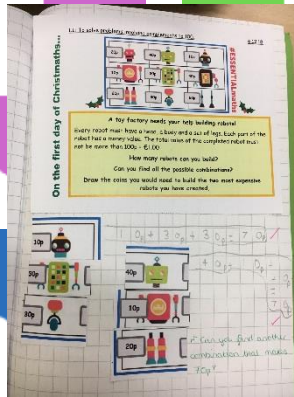


Our Christmas Show
