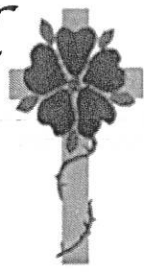
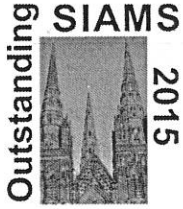

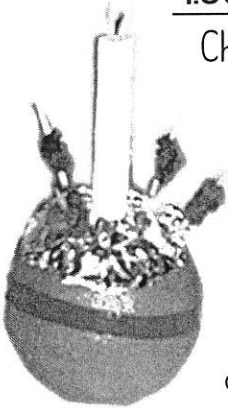

Christingle Service - Reception

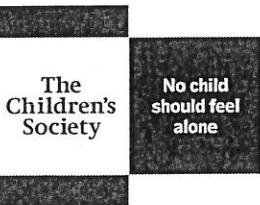
