In R.E. and personal and social education we are thinking about


- What it means to be a Jew and the importance of Moses to Jewish people.

- Comparing and ordering fractions.
- Learning to measure length, weight and capacity.

- Revising prefixes and suffixes.
- Inferring and explaining characters' thoughts and feelings.
- Discovering different types of poetry.
- Deciding how effective my writing is and how I can improve it.
- Researching and writing about the Stone Age.
