In my topics I will be asking

- What do I know about my local area?

In mathematics I will concentrate on

- Accurately drawing 2D shapes with given dimensions and exploring angles.
- Recording and comparing time in seconds, minutes and hours.
- Revising and consolidating the 2, 5, 10, 3 and 4 times tables.
- Making sure we can count in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s from any given number.
- Practising our 8 times tables.
- Using number facts we already know and using the inverse to work out calculations and check our answers.
- Improving my mathematical reasoning skills. 'I know this because...', 'I can prove this answer by ...'.

In English I will be

- Developing my use of noun phrases, prepositional phrases, conjunctions and adverbs to improve my writing.
- Practising punctuating direct speech.
- Revising and learning new homophones.
- Inferring and explaining characters thoughts and feelings.
- Discovering different types of poetry.
- Researching and writing about our local area and the Victorians.
