- What are fossils and why are they so fascinating?
- Why is a diamond so special?

In mathematics I will concentrate on

- Consolidating adding and subtracting amounts of money to give change, using £ and p.
- Using number facts we already know and using the inverse to work out calculations and check our answers.
- Improving my mathematical reasoning skills. 'I know this because...', 'I can prove this answer by ...'.

In English I will be

- Using the past perfect tense when appropriate in writing.
- Revising and consolidating all the features of writing we have learnt this year.
- Using what I know to make my writing as good as it can be in all my lessons.
- Making sure I can proof read and edit my own work.
- In reading, finding words and language that writers have used to create effects.
