



Year 2 Spring Term Theme

- **Language, Oracy and Literacy**

Children will be writing a diary account of someone that was on the Titanic. They will also be writing a non-fiction report on this historic event.

- **Maths**

Children will begin the term with a place value recap and then they will use their skills in the four functions to solve problems with money. They will be finding different combinations for the same amount of money and solving different problems including giving change.

Theme title
The Titanic

Context: This term the children will be learning about the Titanic sinking and how this has changed history. We will be comparing the experience for the different roles on board the great ship and discuss how they differed. We will be having a “Titanic day”, where the children will have the opportunity to explore the different roles on board the Titanic.

Place and Time

Children will be looking at the location of the Atlantic Ocean and the route the Titanic was taking. Children will be looking at a significant event beyond living memory.

- **Arts and Creativity**

The children will be looking at Winter Art by the artist Pieter Brugel. They will also be researching, designing and making their own boats.

- **Science and Technology**

Children will be identifying, classifying and comparing different materials and how they are suitable for particular uses. They will be finding out how solid objects can change shape.

- **Faith and Beliefs**

Children will be learning about Islam and how followers of this religion believe that by making good choices will keep creation in harmony. They will also be learning stories about the prophets.

- **Physical and Emotional Health**

This term the children will be looking at progressing their balancing skills in gymnastics. In Dance, we will be exploring some American dance styles, such as “the twist” and line dancing.
