Fantastic news! The Red class will be doing their first set of this year's Forest School sessions as stated above. This is an exciting learning opportunity where the children get to experience learning in an outdoor environment in different seasons whether it is rain or shine. To make the experience as enjoyable as possible the children need to wear appropriate clothing for the weather.

Clothing: all clothing should be old as it **will** get muddy! The school can provide wellington boots and waterproof trousers for all the children if required.

Long sleeve T-shirts/ tops – even if the weather is hot so arms are protected.

Sweatshirt/ jumper

Waterproof coat

Hat/gloves/scarf/socks

Flat shoes/trainers/wellington boots

As all the sessions are in the morning your child can choose to come to school in their forest school clothes, bringing their school uniform to change into before lunch in a bag or alternatively, they can bring in their forest school clothes and get changed in the classroom first thing in the morning. All clothing needs to be brought into school in a named bag and placed on their peg.
