Reading: Please remember to try to read **every day** for 10 minutes. At some point each week please ask an adult to write a small comment in your reading log to let me know how you are getting on at home.

Spellings: The spelling test will be on Wednesday.

Grasshoppers: Adding the suffix **-ed** (1).

If a word ends in 2 consonants, just add **-ed**.

If a word ends in a short vowel sound (a, e, i, o, u) + a consonant, we **double the consonant** before adding **ed**.

painted, hunted, jumped, buzzed, dropped, patted, popped, hugged, chipped, shopped, tapped, spotted, hummed, flipped, stepped, skipped

Owls:

These are your new spellings.

flag, flop, grin, gran, pram, prop, slip, slid

Please look at the rule above too and try: spotted, jumped, shopped
