Wiltshire School term and holiday dates 2020/21 – Consultation

Term dates for Community and Voluntary Controlled schools are set by the Local Authority in consultation with neighbouring Authorities, schools, groups representing school staff and parents.

Previous consultations have indicated an overwhelming wish for schools to retain a calendar of 195 days, so as to permit the setting of five staff development days within term time dates. There have also been discussions with other Local Authorities in the South West Region in order to agree, as far as possible, common proposed dates.

It was agreed by the Schools Joint Consultative Committee at their meeting on the 15th November to consult on 2 options:

Option 1: Shows a proposed calendar with a five day break in October, with Term 6 ending on Wednesday 21st July. This is the option favoured by our neighbouring authorities.

Option 2: Shows a proposed calendar with a seven day October break, with Term 6 ending on Friday 23rd July.

All comments received will be taken into consideration during the final decision making process.

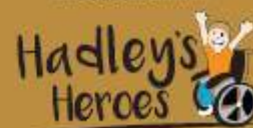

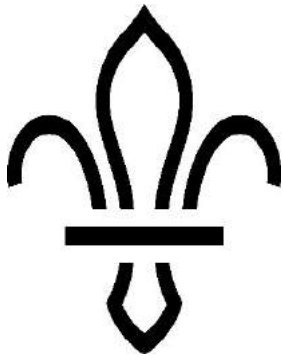
