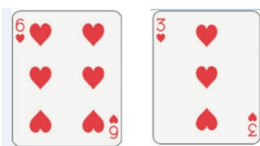


This Week

In maths the children played a game to support them in finding the difference with numbers. We also found that number lines helped as they show the distance between the 2 numbers going backwards and forwards.

WIN THE DIFFERENCE!



1. Choose card
2. Decide who has the greatest number.
3. Draw the difference on numberline
4. Say the difference and the child with greatest number takes that amount of counters



We linked English and computing this week creating algorithms for wrapping a present. I showed the class this video to help explain that an algorithm is a set of instructions for a computer <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Da5TOXCwLSg>

The children then wrote some instructions on how to wrap a present using time connectives (first, then, next, after) and bossy verbs (pull, cut, cover, wrap).
