

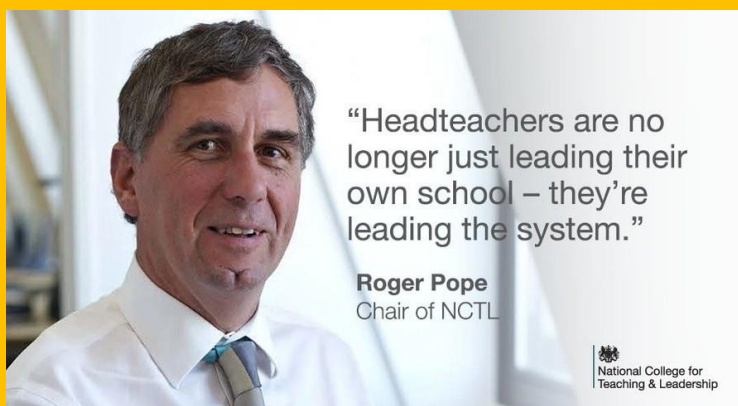
Aspiring Local Leaders of Education (LLE's) Information Event.

Local Leaders of Education (LLE) are serving head teachers who have the capacity and capability to make a significant contribution to supporting schools in their local area. As part of the National College for Teaching and Leadership's (NCTL) move towards an improved school-led system, the NCTL will no longer designate LLEs. Instead, NCTL have provided teaching schools, such as the Arch Alliance Teaching School, the ability to recruit and designate school leaders in this role.

As an LLE you may be required to support other headteachers to achieve sustainable school improvement through coaching and mentoring. The precise role of the LLE is flexible based on context but the schools most likely to benefit from LLE support are where the headteacher:

- would benefit from peer challenge and support to ensure impact in key improvement priorities
- is looking to develop fresh perspectives on issues presenting considerable challenge
- is new and would benefit from assistance in the transition period to maintain momentum in their school's improvement
