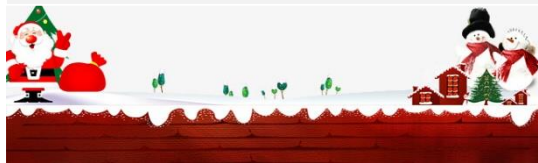


Autumn 7 Newsletter End of Term 2018
