Science

We will be learning all about animals including humans. The focus of this unit will be skeletons and muscles. We will continue to develop our working scientifically skills.

Thematic Curriculum (History, Geography, DT)

Our topic is *Angry Earth* and we will explore a range of natural disasters and volcanoes. Additionally, we will explore the processes that occurs when an earthquake takes place. The children will also familiarise themselves with the technical vocabulary when discussing these effects. Linking to last term's learning, we will focus in on the eruption of Mount Vesuvius and the destruction of Pompeii. In DT, the children will design, build and test an earthquake proof house.

Health and Well-being (Art, Music, Sport)

In music, we will be focussing on structures in a range of music which will be used to create non-standard notation to represent the music they play, sing and hear.

Just as earthquakes and volcanoes create new visuals by a process of destruction, so shall Y3 as they explore the explosive and expressive techniques of Cy Twombly and Cai Guo-Qiang.

In PE, we will be starting our unit on gymnastics. We will be improving our moves and performance. Swimming will continue every Friday morning.
