

PE

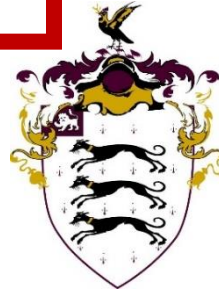
This half term we will be focussing on gymnastics skills as well as lots of talking about healthy lifestyles and the benefits of exercise.

English

In English we will be reading information texts about famous figures from the past. This will help us to develop our We will then use the correct features to write information texts of our own.

Judaism and Questions

Science

We will be asking questions about our environment and then investigating to find the answers. This may be through fair testing or by researching using information books.

Computing

In Computing, we will be learning about how to be safe online and how to be a good online citizen.

Geography

We will be asking questions about the World and then using atlases and information books to find the answers.

The questions will involve naming the continents, parts of the UK, naming Oceans and Seas as well as finding the significant countries of the world.

Forest School

We are very lucky to have our Forest School afternoons in the Spring Term. Every Tuesday morning, we will be in the Forest School solving team and individual challenges. We will be out in all weathers so the children will need separate clothing appropriate to the weather but would include wellies, warm socks, waterproof trousers, gloves, hats and warm coats.

SEAL

In this unit we will look at some of the feelings that are associated with close relationships, particularly in the family and with friends. We will discuss how we feel when someone is more successful or luckier than us. This includes feeling jealous and feeling proud on their behalf. We will think about feelings of hurt, in ourselves and others, and how to manage these feelings.

RE

This unit enables pupils to think about what might be found in a Jewish home and how these objects link to the Jewish way of life. There is a focus on the mezuzah, the belief in one God, Shabbat and Chanukah. This unit also has strong links with Torah, Synagogue and Pesach. We will also start to make connections between Judaism, Islam and Christianity.

Maths

We will be starting this half by linking our multiplication and division learning to develop our understanding of fractions. Our first parent's session will be all about fractions and will be on Tuesday 13th January at 5.30pm.

This half term we will be having a big push on developing our arithmetic skills using all four operations. An example of an arithmetic paper is attached.

We will be continuing our target test focussed on shape for the first 2 weeks and then we will focus on telling the time on an analogue clock.
