These values underpin our learning – making decisions, feelings, rules, right, wrong, develop self-confidence, VIP's, differences, respect and celebrations.

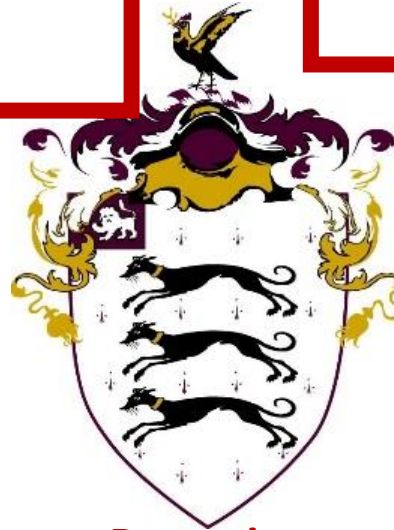

Number and Shape, Space and Measure

To count reliably with numbers 1-10 and beyond

Recognise and count out objects from a larger group

Count actions or objects that cannot be moved

Select the correct numeral to represent 1-10 objects and beyond

Counts objects to 10 and beyond

Counts an irregular arrangement of up to 10 objects and beyond

Children use everyday language to talk about size, weight and capacity to compare quantities and objects and to solve problems.

Orders two or three items by length or height

Order two items by weight or capacity
