Show me your smart counting you could use pairs of socks, coins, pictures, or other objects to help.

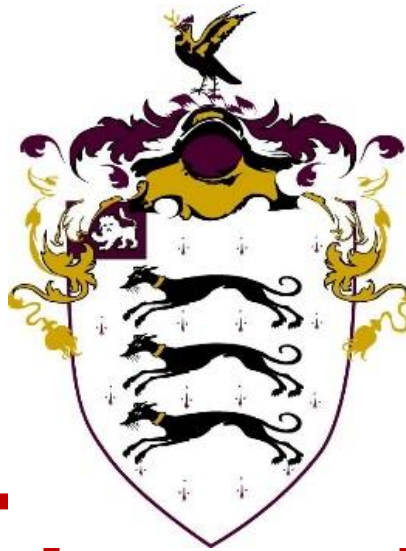
Most children still need to work on forming their numbers correctly.
