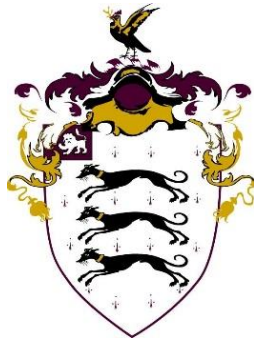


The children have worked hard on their learning this half term and this has been evident in their assessments.
