They will also learn the features of non-fiction texts and have a go at writing their own.

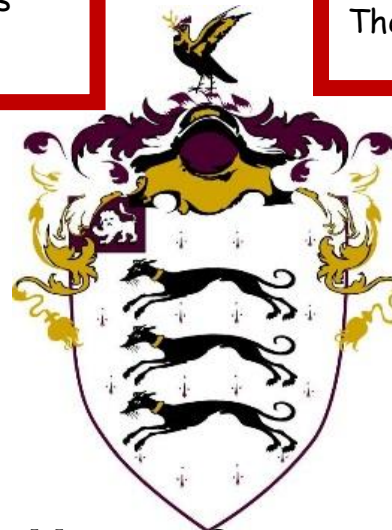
## Maths
