While these devices provide children with hours of entertainment, they can also present new risks. We have attached some advice from the 'Thinkyknow' website, with this newsletter, to help you make sure that young people are safer online over the Christmas period and beyond.

A number of our children have talked about feeling tired in school after playing many hours a day, before and after school, on the 'Fortnight' game.
