CAP Care

During the Christmas period we have received a significant letter from CAP appealing for additional and continuing financial funding for its work in Wakefield in supporting those in poverty and want, particularly people who are homeless. During the last 14 years, the Big Lottery Fund grants have provided 82% of CAP's core funding. These have now ended and despite numerous charitable applications, have not been replaced.
