<p>Create your own worded mathematic problems about the Great Fire of London to challenge a friend e.g. There are 10 houses on Pudding Lane. 4 of them have already burnt down. Create a poster about what is the same and what is different.</p> <p>2 house points</p>	<p>Create a map of London, including the key landmarks and places of interest.</p> <p>2 house points</p>	<p>Design and make a poster about the danger of fire and how to ensure you are fire safe.</p> <p>2 house point</p>	<p>Write a diary as if you were there the day of the Great Fire of London.
