### Design Technology at Copley Junior

Our creative children at Copley Junior enjoy design technology activities linked to their study of different projects.

In Year 3 children have made their own 'fossils' as part of their 'Predators' project. Once children had made their own small fossil they created a scale model of a Tyrannosaurus Rex using huge amounts of modelling rock and white paint.



Year 3 also made some very impressive models of predators.



In their project on Vikings children in Year 4 created Viking longboats; Viking embroidery patterns and small Anglo-Saxon charms.



As part of their project on the Pharaohs, Year 5 children designed and made canopic jars using papier mache and lots of gold paint.
