<i>Prime Area Communication and Language</i>	<i>We will play games and sing songs. We will talk about past, present and future events. We will read fiction and non-fiction books related to our 'Around the World' topic. We will begin to recognise rhymes and rhyming strings.</i>
<i>Prime Area Physical Development</i>	<i>We will continue to dress and undress for role-play and PE. We will continue to develop our fine motor skills in our funky fingers activities. We will practise writing our names with correct letter formation.</i>
<i>Prime Area Personal, Social and Emotional Development</i>	<i>The main focus will be upon going for goals. We will be reflecting upon how to treat others, how to resolve disagreements and how to be a good friend. We will be discussing and thinking about looking after ourselves and making sure that we can look after our own personal needs.</i>
<i>Specific Area Literacy</i>	<i>We will learn the phase 3 phonemes and tricky words and begin our guided reading lessons with Bug Club. We will also be sending home high frequency words and tricky words to help your child with word recognition. We will continue to practise letter formation and develop emergent writing skills.</i>
<i>Specific Area Mathematics</i>	<i>We will continue with our number recognition to twenty and beyond, counting and ordering numbers and will use ordinal numbers in connection with the story 'Handa's Surprise'. We will continue to look at calculations and take part in a variety of numeracy challenges. We will sort and weigh fruits and vegetables and make comparisons with size. We will begin to identify coins of different values, and use these to pay for items in the role play area.</i>
<i>Specific Area Understanding the world</i>	<i>We are learning to use our senses to explore the world around us using a range of maps, photographs and stories. We will be working on the computer and the interactive whiteboard on</i>
