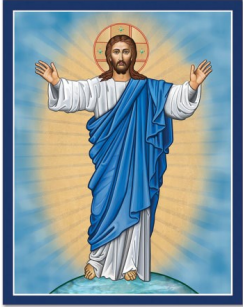

## KS2 Mass 'Christ the Light'

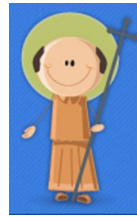
Friday the 18th January
