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Measuring the impact of PPG spending

As a result of the courses attended, the resources purchased and the interventions carried out the impact of the PPG for 2012-13 was as follows:

- 100% of children receiving PPG made National Expected progress in Reading, Writing and Maths.
- 89% of children receiving PPG made above National Expected progress in Reading, Writing and Maths.
- All children in the school were more enthusiastic about reading using the new scheme. (evidence from pupil feedback)
