Nature of support 2017-2018

The funding received from pupil premium has been allocated in the following ways:

- Payment for residential visit.
- Payment for theatre trips, educational visits and visitors into school.
- Payment for after-school club.
- Payment for music tuition.
- Payment for after-school sports coaching.
- Increased teaching assistant support to increase targeted support in phonics, reading, writing and maths, including LA and HA pupils.

Future plans for 2017 – 2018 include:

- Increased learning resources including ICT access that may not be available at home, especially iPads and laptops.
- Additional training for all staff.

Impact

During the academic year 2017 – 2018 based on teacher assessments and national tests against national curriculum criteria and average points scores:

- *Children with FSM made equal or better progress in Reading, Writing and Maths compared with all other pupils. This proves that the impact of spending PPG is raising standards in comparison to national expectations. The impact of spending will be closely monitored as the pupils move through the school.*



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
