Understanding the World.

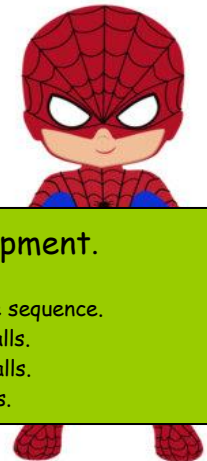
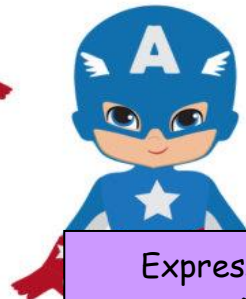
I can talk about some real life super heroes.
