Prime Areas

The children have been busy making Christmas decorations. We have also made costumes for the Nativity.

In PE, the children have been learning their dances for the Nativity and thinking about the different ways that they can move their bodies to music.

In Communication and Language, the children have been talking about the changes that they observed during Forest School in the frosty weather.

Specific Areas

In literacy, the children are learning all about the Elves and writing special letters to post through the elves door! We have started talking why we celebrate Christmas. We are still re-capping our sounds that we have learnt so far:

and they are writing cvc words eg pin, dog, cat.

In maths the children have been learning about subtracting using objects and number lines. We are beginning to write subtracting number sentences together.
