## SFA

## History, Geography, Art, D&T and ICT

Our geography will look at traditional tales; this will include creating a map to grandma's house from the story of Little Red Riding Hood. We will also be taking a closer look at the UK, locating the four countries, their capitals and the surrounding seas.

## Numeracy
