

Breakfast Club Policy - St Benet's Catholic Primary School



Welcome to our Breakfast Club

Aims

The club provides:

- Breakfast to those attending – toast with a choice of toppings and a choice of cereals and a drink. Fruit is also available.
- A safe nurturing environment for children prior to the start of the day, giving them the opportunity to chat to their friends and play
- Alternative provision for children and working parents

Breakfast Club

Is open from 7.50 to 8.50am daily during term time and is held in the EYFS building on the top playground. As the children arrive they are offered breakfast, which is eaten together at the table, with children being encouraged to choose and spread their own toast toppings and pour their own milk for cereal. Once they have eaten, children are also encouraged to share the responsibility of clearing up their own plates and utensils.

After breakfast children are able to chat or play board games inside. If the weather permits, children are able to play outside in the playground – under supervision – until school starts.

At 8.50am younger children are escorted to their classrooms and older children to the playground, where the teacher on duty will be supervising.

The cost of Breakfast Club is £3.50 per child, per day.

If a child arrives after 8.30am the cost of the session is £2 but no breakfast will be offered, as clearing up will be underway.

Safeguarding

Children are carefully supervised at all times and there are two staff members running the club at all times. Other members of staff are on the school site if problems arise or another person is required.

All supervisors are DBS checked and First Aid trained.

A maximum of 20 places are available for Breakfast Club to ensure adequate staff supervision. Therefore booking in advance is expected via Wisepay, except in an emergency, when we will do our best to accommodate your needs. The school does however retain the right to refuse entry if pre-booking hasn't occurred and the numbers attending are deemed to be unsafe with the entry of further children.

Breakfast Club is run by Mrs Sheen who is in attendance every day and is assisted by Mrs Woodgate and Mrs Downes depending on the day of the week.

Booking is to be made via Wisepay – please go to the school website and use the icon on the front page to be taken directly to the sign in area.

Breakfast Club is free for children eligible for Pupil Premium, please contact the school office for further information.
