

English

In English this term we will be learning to:

- Write a setting description based on the book 'Stone Age Boy'.
- Write a diary entry based on the book 'Stone Age Boy'.
- Write a set of instructions based on the book 'How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth'.
- Write an adventure narrative.

History

In History this term we will be learning to about the Stone Age to Iron Age period. We will:

- Use evidence to ask questions and find answers to questions about the past.
- Describe different accounts of a historical event, explaining some of the reasons why the accounts may differ.
- Describe the characteristic features of the past, including ideas, beliefs, attitudes and experiences of men, women and children.
- Use dates and terms to describe events.

Computing

In Computing this term we will be using Purple Mash to:

- Control motion by specifying the number of steps to travel, direction and turn.
- Add text strings, show and hide objects and change the features of an object.
- Select sounds and control when they are heard, their duration and volume.
- Participate in class social media accounts.
- Understand online risks and the age rules for sites.

Maths

In Maths this term we will be learning to:

- Count from 0 in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100.
- Read and write numbers up to 1000.
- Compare and order numbers up to 1000.
- Addition & Subtraction – mentally including three digit numbers.
- Addition & Subtraction – up to three digit numbers using the column method.
- Use our estimating skills to answer a calculation.
- Solve problems, using number facts, place value and more complex addition & subtraction.

Geography

In Geography this term we will be learning to:

- Use maps, atlases, globes and digital computer mapping to locate countries and describe features studied
- Locate the geographic zones of the world.

PE

In PE this term we will be:

- Throw and catch with control and accuracy.
- Strike a ball and field with control.
- Follow the rules of the game and play fairly.

Music

In Music this term we will be learning to:

- Maintain a simple part within a group.
- Pronounce words within a song clearly.

Science

Rocks

- Compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their simple, physical properties.
- Relate the simple physical properties of some rocks to their formation (igneous or sedimentary).
- Describe in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within sedimentary rock.
- Recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.

RE

- Explain how beliefs about right and wrong affect people's behaviour.
- Identify religious artefacts and explain how and why they are used.
- Describe religious buildings and explain how they are used.

Art and Design

This term we will:

- Recreate cave paintings using a variety of sketching techniques.
- Use clay and other materials to sculpt our own caves.
- Use our cooking skills to ensure our understanding of the different kinds of rocks.
