- 2) Ms Hardman to explain the role of the eco team and we will also share a copy of the eco code. *All the children were excited to be part of the eco team and some of the year 2s were able to discuss what the eco code means to them.*
- 3) The eco team will then be asked to help fill out our environmental review. *The team filled out the review - a copy can be seen on the eco board.*
- 4) Children will be informed of our 10 possible topics: marine action, biodiversity, energy, litter, waste, transport, water, school grounds, healthy living and global citizenship. *The children were keen to follow some of these topics up.*
- 5) Children will be told about the plans to raise money for Thrive Village next Monday (8th October) – which KS1 children would like to offer to help before/after school to encourage people to put their coins down on a map of Africa. (I will do message their parents to let them know) *A list of children who volunteered was created and their parents were informed on DOJO to bring them to school earlier on Monday.*
- 6) Photo of the new eco team to be taken *A photo was taken and it will be displayed on the board and in the eco file.*
- 7) The team will be told the date of the next meeting will be Wednesday 14th November at 2.30 p.m.
- 8) We will discuss what can/cannot go in the green recycling bins – looking at a guide sheet to help. The children will be then be asked to make sure that adults/children know where the recycling bins are in their class rooms and they will be given a sheet to be put on their class bin to help know what can be recycled inside it. Children to be shown where the eco bins and solar panel readings are in the playground and

school entrance. The children were given a poster showing what should go in each bin to display in the classroom or on their recycling bin. They were asked to go through with their class what should go in what bin.
