- 2) *Children will be reminded of our 10 possible topics: marine action, biodiversity, energy, litter, waste, transport, water, school grounds, healthy living and global citizenship. Last year we covered global: Fairtrade/send a cow/forever angels/ Thrive/toilet twinning: Water: Toilet twinning/taps off: Marine – Turtle posters: Biodiversity – planting, selling rhubarb, what’s under your feet, Energy, switch off campaign, Waste – recycling.*
The older members of the team remembered some of these campaigns – even the younger ones remembered the toilets! However knowledge of Fairtrade was very poor so we decided that we needed to have another push on it this year and make sure that the children understood the logo and how the process of Fairtrade helps others.
- 3) *This year we need to do more for transport, Fairtrade 25th Feb-10th March, Thrive, healthy lunch boxes, Waste - recycling - children and parents. Energy – monitors to ensure lights/computers/stereos off. Water waste from taps.*
The children recognised the need for these campaigns and talked about how teachers need to make sure they do not leave their computers on if they are not around. We did have to say that they might have to put to sleep if coming back to it to save losing data/programs they had ready to use.
- 4) *Create list of essentials to help become eco classes – scrap tray, monitors- any other ideas?*
The children indicated that they already had these set up in their rooms apart from the unit children who were unsure where there scrap tray was and children from Chestnut who did not think they had scrap tray/ monitors – this is possibly due to staff change over so we will liaise with the teachers to make sure they get them up and running.
- 5) *We also need to create a new eco code (Jan meeting)* **Children were okay with this.**
- 6) *If time look at palm oil advert – do the children think we can do anything?*

The children were very shocked at this and when asked what they wanted to do they said – have billboards and stand outside the gate telling people. They also suggested putting on DOJO to inform parents. I suggested posters –and we had a vote but – standing with billboards won!
