

## ENGLISH



- To write an action scene from a myth. The story we are focusing on is Beowulf.
- The children will write an action 'combat' scene between a hero and a mythical creature.
- The children will be using the film *The Girl and The Fox* as a stimulus.
- The children will concentrate on using prepositional phrases to place the action, the use of effective and powerful verbs and varying sentence length for impact. They will also learn how to use powerful conjunctions
- The children will continue to work on the year 5 spellings.

## ART

## MATHS

The children will learn to/about :

- The children will be learning about area and perimeter.
- They will be learning to understand Fractions including decimals & percentages
- They will multiply and divide drawing upon known number facts.
- They will also learn to multiply numbers up to 4 digits using a written formal method.
- The children will learn to divide numbers up to 4 digits using the written formal method and interpret remainders in context

## Music

All the learning is focused around one song: Make You Feel My Love.

The children will play games linked to pulse, rhythm, and pitch. They will play instruments and sing.

## P.E.

The children will be learning how to assess and improve their own fitness levels.

Children will also be learning to play netball.

## SCIENCE

In science the children will learn how to describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system.

They will also use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night, and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky.



## R.E.



The children will be exploring the question: How can we make our town a more respectful place?

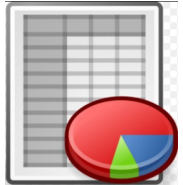


## GEOGRAPHY

In geography the children will identify the position and significance of latitude, longitude, Equator, Northern Hemisphere, Southern Hemisphere, the Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn, Arctic and Antarctic Circle. They will also develop an understanding of Prime/Greenwich Meridian and time zones (including day and night)

## COMPUTING

In computing the children will be learning about spreadsheets. They will learn how to use different tools and end the topic by using the spreadsheet to plan an event.



## FRENCH

In French the children will be learning the days of the week and months of the year. They will be learning to write the date in French.

## PSHE

In PSHE the children will learn about keeping themselves safe and managing risks:

- about keeping safe online
- that violence within relationships is not acceptable
- about problems that can occur when someone goes missing from home
