<p>Mathematics: We will be building on the children's knowledge of the four operations and recapping over formal methods which they use to solve problems. We will also be looking at 2D and 3D shapes and the angles within them. In measurement, we will be focusing on finding the area and perimeter of different shapes.</p>	<p>Practice times tables everyday. <p>Science: Over the course of the Spring term, we will be learning about sound. We will be carrying out a range of investigations to help understand how sound travels, how it can be blocked and spreads out with movement. Following this we will be focusing on how sound is created from vibrations and how these vibrations help us to hear sounds. Throughout each lesson, we will be using a range of skills to ensure we are working scientifically.</p>	<p>Ask children each week about the investigations which they completed.
