Curriculum Overview for History

The aims of History at Johnson Fold are to help pupils gain a coherent knowledge and understanding of Britain’s past and that of the wider world. We aim to inspire pupils’ curiosity to know more about the past.

Children will be taught to ask perceptive questions, think critically, weigh evidence, sift arguments, and develop perspective and judgement.

Where possible, children will be given the opportunity to engage with real artefacts from the past and to visit local places of interest if relevant to their curriculum.

History lessons at Johnson Fold aim to provide children with an opportunity to find out about and research the past and, where necessary, look at the reliability of the sources of their information gathering.

Historical enquiry skills are often revisited throughout each year group in order to secure and refine the skills in a variety of contexts and historical events.
